

2020-2021 VoAg Supply List

Middle School:

Grades 6-7: Chromebook, pencil, paper and a folder to keep papers assignments in.

Students should plan on spending a large portion of their time in the shop. Basic woodworking is focus.

Optional Recommended Supplies: Shop Coat or shirt, gloves, extra change of clothes including shoes.

Grade 8: Chromebook, pencil, paper and a folder to keep papers assignments in.

Students should plan on spending a large portion of their time in the shop.

Welding will be the focus along with woodworking.

Optional Recommended Supplies: Shop Coat or shirt, gloves, extra change of clothes including shoes (items you don't mind getting dirty or ruined). Full leather gloves, NO synthetic material (it melts).

Projects: A basic metal project will be supplied by the school, please bring ideas for a beginning woodworking or a basic welding project.

Grades 9-10: Chromebook, pencil, paper and a folder to keep papers assignments in.

Students should plan on spending a large portion of their time in the shop.

Welding will be the focus along with intermediate woodworking. Electricity will also be covered.

Optional Recommended Supplies: Shop Coat or shirt, gloves, extra change of clothes including shoes (items you don't mind getting dirty or ruined). Full leather gloves, NO synthetic material (it melts).

Projects: Students will need 4-5 individual project ideas for either woodworking or welding. Please do not purchase materials prior to the first day of class.

Grades 11-12: Chromebook, pencil, paper and a folder to keep papers assignments in. Students should plan on spending a large portion of their time in the shop.

Optional Recommended Supplies: Shop Coat or shirt, gloves, extra change of clothes including shoes (items you don't mind getting dirty or ruined). Full leather gloves for metal work. Mechanic type gloves can be used general purpose

Projects: Each student needs to have their own individual Recycle, Re-purpose, Re-use (RRR) project. There are a variety of options out there from refinishing an old desk to making something new from scrap pieces. When the first project is finished, students will need a second project to finish out the term. Plan for enough small projects or one difficult project to last a semester.

Students must have a RRR project and materials by the class drop/add date or they will be removed from the class.
